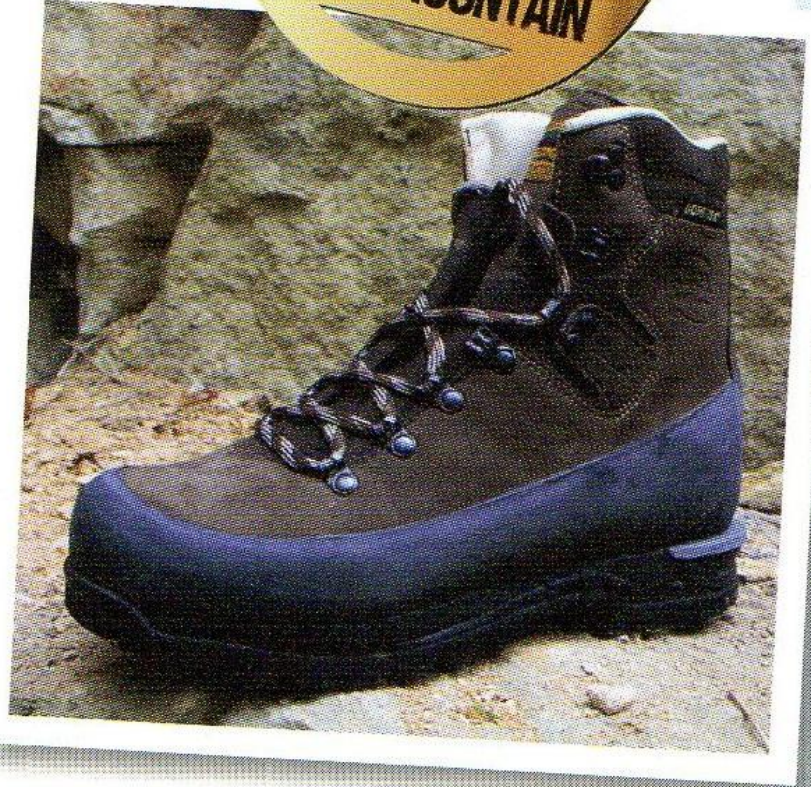

The Himalayas look the part as soon you take them out of the box, the massive rubber rand showing they mean business. The nubuck upper is sumptuous and features a minimum of stitching. The outer sole is pretty rigid while the medium depth tread will work well on both mud and on rock. From the box, these are one of the most comfortable boots you will find, aided by Meindl's

memory foam system (hence the MFS in the name). The high ankle collar gives as much support as you could ever want. Although it's the most expensive boot in our test, the Himalaya is a top quality product that is man enough for the toughest walks or treks.

Verdict: Bombproof boot for year-round hillwalking and trekking
